AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING VARIOUS LOCATIONS FOR STOP SIGNS IN CONCORD VINEYARD SUBDIVISION:

IT HAS COME TO THE ATTENTION OF THE LaPORTE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT:

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that stop signs be posted at various locations in the Concord Vineyard Subdivision by the County Highway Engineer.

WHEREAS, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS HAVE REVIEWED THE RECOMMENDATION.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LaPORTE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT:

The County Code Chapter 7 Article 2 (Specific Road Sign Designations) Section 7-14b. Paragraph 43 now reserved shall be and it hereby is as follows:

- "43. a) On the east end of Burgundy Trail at the S.W. corner where Burgundy Trail intersects Malaga Drive for eastbound traffic.
 - b) On the west end of Burgundy Trail at the N.E. corner where Burgundy Trail intersects Malaga Drive for westbound traffic.
 - c) On the west end of Burgundy Court at the N.E. corner where Burgundy Court opens into Malaga Drive for westbound traffic."
