**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND CONTROLLING SPEED LIMITS ON
COUNTY ROAD 400 EAST IN KANKAKEE TOWNSHIP
NORTH OF U.S. 2 AND SOUTH OF U.S. 20**

**IT HAS COME TO THE ATTENTION OF THE
LAPORTE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT:**

WHEREAS, County residents have requested that a missing speed limit sign be replaced;

WHEREAS, the County Highway Engineer has determined that there is no Ordinance establishing a speed limit on County Road 400 East;

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has performed all statutory designated speed limit analysis and recommends a speed limit of 45 miles per hour;

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners have reviewed the request.


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LAPORTE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT:**

The County Code Chapter 7 Article 1 (Speed Limit Designations) Section 7-8 (Forty-Five (45) Miles per Hour) Paragraph 34 now reserved shall be and it hereby is as follows:




**"34. On County Road 400 East in
Kankakee Township North of U.S. 2
and South of U.S. 20."**

**This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect beginning the 15th day of July,
1997, and after its enactment and publication as prescribed by law.**
