

LaPORTE COUNTY ORDINANCE NUMBER 97- 12

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF COUNTY ROAD 1500 SOUTH AND COUNTY ROAD 900 WEST IN CASS TOWNSHIP.

IT HAS COME TO THE ATTENTION OF THE LaPORTE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT:

WHEREAS, certain citizens have requested a four-way stop be established at the intersection of County Road 1500 South and County Road 900 West.

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that stop signs be posted at the intersection of County Road 1500 South and County Road 900 West for north and south bound traffic by the County Engineer.

WHEREAS, THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS HAVE REVIEWED THE REQUEST AND RECOMMENDATION.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LaPORTE COUNTY, INDIANA THAT:

The County Code Chapter 7 Article 2 (Specific Road Sign Designations) Section 7-14b. Paragraph 45 now reserved shall be and it hereby is as follows:


- "45. a) On the northwest corner of County Road 1500 South and County Road 900 West for southbound traffic.
- b) On the southeast corner of County Road 1500 South and County Road 900 West for northbound traffic.
- c) The intersection of County Road 1500 South and County Road 900 West is located in Cass Township."
