

ORDINANCE NO. 98-10  
BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS  
LaPORTE COUNTY, INDIANA

WHEREAS, IC 5-22 (hereinafter referred to as "Act") applies to every expenditure of public funds by a governmental body;

WHEREAS, LaPorte County (hereinafter referred to as "County") is a governmental body under the Act;

WHEREAS, the Act authorizes the County to establish a purchasing agency for the County; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of the County desires to establish a purchasing agency for the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LaPORTE COUNTY, INDIANA:

**SECTION 1:** The Board of Commissioners hereby determines that it is the purchasing agency for the County.

**SECTION 2:** The Board of Commissioners hereby designates the following persons to serve as purchasing agents for the County:

(A) Each elected County official;

(B) Each Circuit, Superior and County Court Judge;


(C) Each County Department head directly appointed by the Board of Commissioners; and

(D) Such County employees as are designated from time-to-time in writing.

**SECTION 2:** This Ordinance is effective upon passage and signing by the presiding officer and publication as provided by law.

Adopted by the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County, Indiana, this 30 day of June, 1998 by a vote of 3 ayes and 0 nays.
