RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF  
LA PORTE COUNTY, INDIANA  
AUTHORIZING THE AUDITOR OF LA PORTE COUNTY TO  
REMOVE DELINQUENT TAXES FROM CERTAIN PARCELS  
AND TRANSFER SAID PARCELS TO THE CITY OF MICHIGAN  
CITY, INDIANA WITH A TAX EXEMPT STATUS

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County, Indiana has received deed to certain parcels of land within the corporation limits of the City of Michigan City, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the City of Michigan City, Indiana seeks to have the parcels deeded to the city to be a portion of their sanitation district property; and




WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners realize there are delinquent taxes due on the said parcels that are requested by the City of Michigan City, Indiana;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County, Indiana that:

1. The Auditor of LaPorte County, Indiana be requested to remove the delinquent taxes from Lots 2,3,5,6 8,9,10,11,12,14,15,16,17,18,19,20,21 of Block 12 of the "OAKLAND" subdivision in Michigan City, Michigan Township, LaPorte County, Indiana as recorded in the Office of the Recorder, LaPorte County, Indiana.
2. That the County of LaPorte, Indiana prepare a Quit Claim Deed and transfer the ownership of the stated property to the City of Michigan City, Indiana and have same recorded in the Office of the Recorder of LaPorte County, Indiana as tax exempt property.
