

ORDINANCE NO. 99-3

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS 8-23 AND SECTION 8-197
OF CHAPTER 8 OF THE LAPORTE COUNTY ZONING
ORDINANCE AND MASTER PLAN

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Plan Commission has initiated a proposal to amend Section 8-23 and Section 8-197 of Chapter 8 of the LaPorte County Ordinance by making an addition to page 78a and by reinserting a new page 171, Section 8-197 of the LaPorte County Master Plan; and,

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Plan Commission has prepared a form of Ordinance providing for these amendments; and,

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Plan Commission has held a properly advertised meeting as required by I.C. 36-7-4-604; and,
WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Plan Commission has certified its recommendation to the LaPorte County Commissioners that Chapter 8 should be amended as set forth below; and,

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Commissioners, after considering recommendation of the LaPorte County Plan Commission, has determined that the present Article 4, Sub-section 8-23 should be amended to include the addition of page 78a as regards to specification on conforming uses and Chapter 8, Article 15, section 8-197 as it pertains to the adoption of zone maps and form as approved by the LaPorte County Plan Commission.

NOW THEREFORE,

Section 1. BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that Chapter 8, Section 8-23 be amended to include the additional sections contained on page 78a for the Master Plan, specifying non-conforming use criteria;


SECTION 2. BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED that Chapter


8, Section 8-197 be amended by a new page 171 specifying the adoption of current zone maps;


SECTION 3. That said page and amendments are attached hereto this Ordinance as Exhibits "A" and "B",


SECTION 4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its approval and publication as required by law.
