

ORDINANCE NO. 99-13
ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH STOP SIGNS AT INTERSECTIONS

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Highway Engineer has recommended to the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners the need to establish stop signs at various intersections in LaPorte County.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. 7-14, (Stop Signs) of the LaPorte County Code is amended to add the following sections to Section 7-14b, which shall read:


- a. **Section 46 CR 800 S.** Stop signs shall be installed at the southeast corner for north bound traffic and at the northwest corner for southbound traffic where CR 800 S intersects Long Lane in Noble Township.
- b. **Section 47 Colson Subdivision.** Stop signs shall be installed on:
 1. Potato Hole Court at CR 800 East in Wills Township.
 2. Colson Court at Potato Hole Court in Wills Township.
- c. **Section 48 Hunter's Run Subdivision.** Stop signs shall be installed on:
 1. Meadow Court at Remington Square.
 2. Remington Square at Hunter's Glen.
 3. The southbound portion of Remington Square where it intersects the East-West portion of Remington Square west of Meadow Court.
 4. Winchester Drive at Remington Square.
 5. Sportsman Lane at Fail Road.
 6. Sportsman Lane at Winchester Drive.
 7. Cove Court at Sportsman Lane.
- d. **Section 49 Concord Vineyard, Unit No. 3 Subdivision.** Stop signs shall be installed on:
 1. Vintage Court where it intersects Malaga Drive (West).
- e. **Section 50 Woods of Concord II Subdivision.** Stop signs shall be installed on:
 1. Meritage Court where it intersects Meritage Trail.
 2. Meritage Trail where it intersects Concord Drive.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect beginning the 12th day of October and after its enactment and publication as prescribed by law.


