**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION SUBMISSION AND LOCAL MATCH COMMITMENT**

RESOLUTION OF THE LAPORTE COUNTY COMMISSION OF THE COUNTY OF LAPORTE, INDIANA, AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE CFF APPLICATION TO THE INDIANA DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE AND ADDRESSING RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, the Commissioners of the County of LaPorte, Indiana recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within its corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Department of Commerce to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community development needs of low and moderate income persons; and

WHEREAS, the County of LaPorte, Indiana has conducted or will conduct public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Department of Commerce, said public hearings to assess the housing, public facilities and economic needs of its low and moderate income residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Commissioners of LaPorte County, Indiana that:


1. The County Commission President is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to address the rehabilitation of the building of the Activity Center for Older Adults (ACOA), and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Department of Commerce and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
2. The County of LaPorte, Indiana hereby commits the requisite local funds in the amount of fifty-six thousand (\$56,000), in the form of funding provided by the Swanson Center, as matching funds for said program, such commitment to be contingent upon receipt of CFF funding from the Indiana Department of Commerce.
