

RESOLUTION FOR DISPOSAL OF PROPERTY 2000, 9

WHEREAS, LaPorte County Auditor has provided a list of properties that have not been sold in two (2) consecutive tax sales and;

WHEREAS, pursuant to I.C. 6-1.1-24-6.7, such property may be transferred to not-for-profit corporations to develop for use for the public good, and;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to conduct a public hearing concerning the disposal of such properties.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County:

Section 1. That a public hearing be held on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2000 concerning the transfer of properties attached hereto as Exhibit "A".


Section 2. Such public hearing to be conducted pursuant to I.C. 6-1.1-24-6.7 to consider the transfer of such properties to non-for-profit corporations for the public good.

Section 3. That any transfer to a not-for-profit corporation must include an agreement for indemnification of LaPorte County regarding any environmental issues or problems concerning such properties transferred.


Section 4. That the Auditor of LaPorte County shall publish a public notice of such hearing pursuant to I.C. 5-3-1.




