RESOLUTION TO FAVOR EXPANSION OF KINGSBURY STATE FISH AND WILDLIFE AREA IN LAPORTE COUNTY

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners previously adopted Resolution 2000-10 to oppose an expansion of the Kingsbury Fish and Wildlife Area in LaPorte County, and;

WHEREAS, since the adoption of that Resolution, other concerns concerning such area have come to light and the Board of Commissioners now deem it in the best interests of LaPorte County to favor the expansion of the Kingsbury Fish and Wildlife Area in LaPorte County, and;

WHEREAS, such expansion is to occur in what was formally land in the part of the old Kingsbury Ordinance Plant.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners that:

SECTION I. Resolution 2000-10 is hereby rescinded.

SECTION II. That the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County hereby express their approval to the proposed expansion of the Kingsbury Fish and Wildlife Area by the acquisition of the additional 3000 acres of the former Kingsbury Ordinance Plant.

SECTION III. That the Auditor of LaPorte County is hereby authorized and directly to forward a copy of this Resolution to the Governor of Indiana, Lieutenant Governor of Indiana and the Director of the Pepartment of Natural Resources.
