

ORDINANCE REGARDING COURTHOUSE  
SECURITY SCANNING

ORDINANCE # 2003-1

WHEREAS, there is a need for increased security measures concerning the LaPorte County Courthouse; and

WHEREAS, there is a need for the security scanning for all individuals entering the LaPorte County Courthouses.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County that:

SECTION I. That all individuals entering into the LaPorte County Courthouses to include employees and the general public, will be required to pass through a metal detection unit and searched, if necessary, prior to entering into any LaPorte County Courthouses.


SECTION II. That the LaPorte County Sheriff and the LaPorte County Courthouse Security detail and provide other additional policies regarding the scanning and the ingress and egress of the LaPorte County employees and other individuals who are known to frequent the Courthouse due to business concerns on a regular basis.


SECTION III. That any individual who fails to abide by the requirements of the LaPorte County Courthouse Security detail shall be denied entry into the LaPorte County Courthouses.

SECTION IV. That this ordinance shall take effect after its publication and passage as prescribed by law.


