**ORDINANCE SETTING SPEED LIMITS
ON ALL COUNTY ROADS**

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the LaPorte County Commissioners that there needs to be a universal speed limit for all county roads unless otherwise established, that speed limit is 55 mph, and;

WHEREAS, it is recommendation that the LaPorte County Commissioners adopt a universal speed limit for all county roads at 45 mph and the same should be established for all county roads.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County that:


SECTION I. SECTION 7-8 of the LaPorte County code is hereby repealed and amended to read as follows:


- A. All LaPorte County roads not otherwise having a separate speed limit adopted by the Board of Commissioners shall have a speed limit of 45 mph.
- B. The speed limit of 45 mph shall be considered a universal county speed limit for all such county roads unless a speed limit is adopted for a specific road or section of road in LaPorte County.
- C. That all ordinances currently in effect establishing a lesser or higher speed limit for specific roads, shall remain in full force and effect unless amended or rescinded.


SECTION II. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and subject to any publication and posting as provided by law.


