ORDINANCE NO. 2005-08

Enacted on the 4th day of JUNE, 2005.

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF A PUBLIC STREET THIRTY (30) FEET WIDE SHOWN AS PANSY LANE

WHEREAS, NEFTALIE and HEATHER ALVA and JOHN and EVELYN HALL have filed a petition with the LaPorte County Commissioners under the provisions of Indiana Code 36-7-3-12 and 36-7-3-13 for the vacation of a portion of Pansy Lane.

WHEREAS, notice of a hearing before the LaPorte County Commissioners has been published in the LaPorte Herald Argus in its issue of April 1, 2005, publication being as least ten (10) days before the date of this hearing; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable and in the best interests of LaPorte County, Indiana, to vacate said portion of Pansy Lane (a) because petitioners own all contiguous property, (b) that the vacation of said portion of Pansy Lane will not materially damage the adjoining property, and will relieve the County of LaPorte of future responsibility for maintaining the same, and (c) will add the property vacated to the tax rolls of the County of LaPorte, Indiana.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE LAPORTE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS of the County of LaPorte, Indiana, as follows:

SECTION 1.

That the portion of Pansy Lane adjacent to Lots 4949 thru 4952 and Lots 5048 thru 5052 of Hudson Lake Beach is hereby vacated, and in accordance with the law of the State of Indiana, the fee simple title to the vacated portion of Pansy Lane reverts to the adjoining property owners, i.e. NEFTALIE and HEATHER ALVA and JOHN and EVELYN HALL.

SECTION 2.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its approval and passage by the LaPorte County Commissioners of LaPorte County, Indiana, as required by law.
