

RESOLUTION NO. 2007-6

**A RESOLUTION OF THE LAPORTE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS
REGARDING THE RETIREMENT OF ARRAS, A K-9 DOG.**

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Commissioners have been advised by Sheriff Mollenhauer that "Arras", a K-9 dog, is no longer fit for duty by the LaPorte County Sheriff's Office.

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the LaPorte County Commissioners that "Arras" is unfit for the purpose for which he was acquired and is no longer of use to the County of LaPorte; and

WHEREAS, Bruce Kluge has agreed to care for "Arras" at his own expense and to keep him as a house pet and understands that "Arras" can never again be used as a Police Dog; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff of LaPorte County has submitted this statement advising that the dog is no longer fit for the purpose for which he was intended, to be a member of the Canine Unit of the LaPorte County Sheriff's Office, and is therefore no longer needed by the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the LaPorte County Commissioners that "Arras", a K-9 Police Dog, is unfit for the purpose for which he was acquired, is no longer of use to the County of LaPorte, and has an estimated value of less than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00).


