

ORDINANCE NO. 2009-04

**AN ORDINANCE TO VACATE A ROADWAY PLATTED IN
INDIANA BAPTIST ASSEMBLY GROUNDS**

WHEREAS, petitioner, KENNETH S. GUDINO, President of the Pine Lake Assembly, Successor in interest in the Indiana Baptist Assembly, has filed a Petition for vacation of an undeveloped roadway that was originally platted in the Indiana Baptist Assembly Grounds that extends from Holton Road to what was originally designated as Judson Road, but is presently named as Holton Road located in Section 27 and 28 of Center Township, LaPorte County, Indiana; and,

WHEREAS, petitioner is the owner of land which abuts said public way; and,

WHEREAS, the property owners of all adjoining and abutting lots have been served with notice of public hearing pursuant to Indiana statute; and,

WHEREAS, notice of public hearing on the Petition was published in the LaPorte Herald Argus on the ___ day of April, 2009; and,

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on the 19th day of May, 2009, in the Chambers of the LaPorte County Commissioners, in the LaPorte County Courthouse, 813 Lincolnway, LaPorte, Indiana, at which hearing all interested parties were given an opportunity to present their views for and against the granting of the petition to vacate; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the adjacent property owners that the petition be granted and the road be vacated; and,

WHEREAS, the Commissioners have determined that the petition to vacate the road should be granted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED:

SECTION 1. An undeveloped roadway that was originally platted in the Indiana Baptist Assembly Grounds that extends from Holton Road to what was originally designated as Judson Road, but is presently named as Holton Road, as proposed by petitioner KENNETH S. GUDINO, President of the Pine Lake Assembly, Successor in interest in the Indiana Baptist Assembly, be and the same is hereby vacated by the Commissioners of LaPorte County.

SECTION 2. The Clerk shall furnish a certified copy of the Ordinance to the County Recorder for recording and the County Auditor.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage according to law.
