ORDINANCE 2011 - 04

ORDINANCE ESTABLING PARKING RESTRICTIONS FOR THE MICHIGAN CITY COURTHOUSE PARKING LOT

WHEREAS, LaPorte County (the "County") owns property used as a parking lot for the Michigan City Courthouse; and

WHEREAS, the County has further determined it is necessary to establish parking restrictions, including, but not limited to, reserved parking spaces for County officials and employees as well as penalties for anyone that violates such restrictions,

Now, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County that:

1. Title VII, Chapter 72, of the LaPorte County Code shall be amended to add Section 72.03, which shall read as follows:

Title VII, Chapter 72, Section 72.03 Parking at Michigan City Courthouse.

- (A). Parking spaces at the Michigan City Courthouse parking lot shall be designated or otherwise marked and reserved for LaPorte County officials and employees in an amount and in such locations as deemed necessary and appropriate by the County.
- (B). No person shall park in any parking space designated or otherwise marked and reserved in accordance with subsection (A), above.
- (C). Any person in violation of this Section shall be subject to a fine in the amount of Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00), and the violator's vehicle shall be towed at the violator's expense.
- 2. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, posting, and publication as prescribed by law.
