

**ORDINANCE 2011 - 10**

**ORDINANCE DESIGNATING FOUR-WAY STOP AT THE  
INTERSECTION OF C.R. 1400 SOUTH AND LONG LANE**

**WHEREAS**, LaPorte County, by and through its Board of Commissioners, has the authority under I.C. § 9-21-4-11 to designate an intersection as a stop intersection and erect stop signs at one (1) or more entrances to the intersection; and

**WHEREAS**, the intersection of C.R. 1400 South and Long Lane is located within the jurisdiction of LaPorte County; and

**WHEREAS**, LaPorte County has been advised that engineering and traffic investigations of said intersection have been completed; and

**WHEREAS**, the LaPorte County Highway Department recommends that said intersection be designated as a four-way stop and further recommends that appropriate signage be erected,


**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Board of Commissioners of LaPorte County that:

1. Title VII, Chapter 74, Schedule V, Stop Intersections and Signs, of the LaPorte County Code shall be amended to reflect and read that the intersection of C.R. 1400 South and Long Lane is designated as a four-way stop.
2. The LaPorte County Highway Department shall erect all necessary and appropriate stop signs.
3. This Ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, posting and publication as prescribed by law.


