**RESOLUTION CONCURRENCE WITH A
PROPOSAL TO REVISE THE LAPORTE COUNTY
FEDERAL-AID SYSTEM**

WHEREAS, to be eligible for certain types of federal-aid funds a roadway must be on the federal-aid system; and

WHEREAS, after careful analysis by the LaPorte County Highway Engineer based on current and future traffic volumes, current and future development trends and other relevant factors, it have been determined that his revision to the Federal-Aid System should be made.

WHEREAS, LaPorte County is desirous of formally adopting ADAAG and PROWAG as part of the County's continuing effort to implement its ADA Transition Plan and to ensure that LaPorte County is in full and continued compliance with the ADA,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of Commissioners of the County of LaPorte that,

SECTION 1. The following revision is requested to update the functional class system in LaPorte County to reflect accurate system layout and usage:

County Road 950 West

This road, the extension of Cleveland Avenue, IR-439 to function as a major collector.


Existing Functional Classification – Rural Local Road




