

ORDINANCE 2013 - 030003

ORDINANCE TO AMEND SICK LEAVE POLICY

WHEREAS the LaPorte County Commissioners previously adopted Ordinance 2007-12 regarding the elimination of PTO time and reinstating sick leave; and

WHEREAS there is a need for the ordinance to be modified to comply with the current policy.

NOW THEREFORE be it ordained by the LaPorte County Board of Commissioners that:


1. That Ordinance 2007-14 is hereby amended to add the following:

Section II, Personnel Policy Sick Leave


- B. Any employee may accumulate up to sixty (60) days of unused sick time. Any full-time employee with twenty (20) years or more of service shall be paid seventy-five (\$75.00) per day for such accumulated sick time up to a maximum of sixty (60) days upon retirement. The twenty (20) years of service does not have to be consecutive; however, there can be no more than a two (2) year break in service for eligibility. Any full-time EMS field employee with twenty (20) or more years of service may be paid for accumulated sick time up to twenty (20) 24 hour shifts upon retirement.
2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage as prescribed by law.


