**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION SUBMISSION AND LOCAL MATCH  
COMMITMENT**

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF LA PORTE COUNTY  
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE CDBG PLANNING GRANT APPLICATION  
TO THE INDIANA OFFICE OF COMMUNITY AND RURAL AFFAIRS AND  
ADDRESSING RELATED MATTERS**

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of La Porte County recognizes the need to stimulate growth and to maintain a sound economy within corporate limits; and

WHEREAS, The Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, authorizes the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs to provide grants to local units of government to meet the housing and community needs of low and moderate-income residents and/or the elimination of blight; and


WHEREAS, La Porte County has conducted or will conduct public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs, said public hearings to assess the housing, public facilities and economic needs of its low and moderate-income residents;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of La Porte County, that:


1. The Board of Commissioners President or his designee is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to address, **"Planning for the Wastewater Collection System of unincorporated Rolling Prairie, into an extension from the City of La Porte Wastewater Treatment Plant"** and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs, and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
2. La Porte County, Indiana hereby commits the requisite local funds in the amount of three thousand (\$3,000) dollars from the La Porte County Regional Sewer District (sub-recipient) as matching funds- such commitment to contingency upon receipt of CDBG funding from the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs.
