

ORDINANCE NO. 2018 - 4
OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF LAPORTE COUNTY, INDIANA

ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A DEDICATION OF ROADWAY

WHEREAS, The La Porte County Board of Commissioners has hereby conducted a public hearing on September 5, 2018, to determine whether it would recommend the request by Terrance L. Scholl and Lisa S. Scholl ("Petitioners") to dedicate a private road as a public roadway under the Road System of the County of LaPorte, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Petitioners are the owners of a parcel of real estate located in LaPorte County, Indiana, currently containing an address of 311 East Murray Road, LaPorte, Indiana; and

WHEREAS, the Petitioners have constructed a roadway with cul-de-sac running north from Murray Road to the residence occupied by the Petitioners. The approximate boundaries of the roadway constructed by the Petitioners are depicted on Exhibit "A" attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, the Petitioners request dedication of this street so that there is a public roadway to their house and to two (2) other landowners whose real estate would be located along the roadway; and

WHEREAS, the LaPorte County Highway Department and the Kankakee Volunteer Fire Department have been notified, have reviewed the roadway and offer no objection; and

WHEREAS, the Petitioners presented at the September 5, 2018 public meeting consents of all landowners adjoining the roadway.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained as follows:

SECTION I: The County Commissioners hereby approve the request by Terrance L. Scholl and Lisa S. Scholl ("Petitioners") to dedicate a private road as a public roadway under the Road System of the County of LaPorte, Indiana. The roadway as constructed is to be dedicated to LaPorte County and that the roadway be named Dr. Scholl Lane, LaPorte, Indiana.


SECTION II: That this ordinance shall take effect after its publication and passage as prescribed by law.


