ALLEYWAY BETWEEN DEPOT STREET AND MAPLE STREET

WHEREAS, Petitioner, GRIMM DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION ("Petitioner"), has filed a Petition to vacate the 20' un-improved alleyway between Depot Street and Maple Street, located near 200 South Depot Street, Rolling Prairie, County of LaPorte, State of Indiana; and,

The La Porte County Plan Commission has hereby conducted a public hearing on February 26, 2019, to determine whether it would recommend the vacation of

SECTION 2. The Clerk shall furnish a certified copy of the Ordinance to the County Recorder for recording and the County Auditor.

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall be in effect from and after its passage according to law.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall be subject to any and all sewer easements; and installation vehicle shall be later identified by the LaPorte County Regional Sewer and Water District.


