

Indiana General Assembly

The Indiana General Assembly legalized CBD oil in March 2018 and additional rules took effect in July. Those rules require all hemp-derived CBD products sold in stores in Indiana must include a QR code on their label that lets consumers download a product's certificate of analysis (COA) to their phone.
