If you are an attorney filing a new claim and will have an initial hearing set, it needs to state on the Notice of Claim for the defendant to appear telephonically on a certain date, time, phone number to call your office and a contact name. If the defendant(s) fail to appear telephonically, then a default judgment may be entered against them. You would then file the proper motion and proposed order with the court.
- 2. If you are filing a motion and proposed order for a Proceedings Supplemental or any other collection matter where a hearing is set, it needs to state on the paperwork for the defendant to appear telephonically on a certain date, time, phone number to call your office and a contact name. If the defendant(s) fail to appear, you would file the appropriate paperwork with the court.
- 3. The only time a hearing will be set at the courthouse is if the matter is contested and needs to be heard by the judge. If a matter is contested, you would file a motion and proposed order requesting a bench trial either in person or via Zoom with the Magistrate Court for Superior Court 4, third floor, Michigan City, Indiana, (219) 874-5611, Ex 7761.
