**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION SUBMISSION AND
LOCAL MATCH COMMITMENT**

RESOLUTION OF THE LA PORTE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS,
AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF THE STATE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) COVID-19 RESPONSE PROGRAM CV-CV1-230.

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of La Porte County recognizes the plight of businesses within the unincorporated areas due to the COVID-19 virus; and

WHEREAS, The Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs provides grants to local units of government to assist local businesses and low and moderate-income employees of said businesses, trying to mitigate the negative financial effects of COVID-19; and


WHEREAS, La Porte County has conducted or will conduct public hearings prior to the submission of an application to the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs, said public hearings to alert the public of the intent of pursuing COVID-19 Immediate Relief Grant Funds;

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of La Porte County, that:

1. The Board of Commissioners President or his/her designee is authorized to prepare and submit an application for grant funding to address, "COVID-19 Relief Funds for Unincorporated Businesses" and to execute and administer a resultant grant including requisite general administration and project management, contracts and agreements pursuant to regulations of the Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs, and the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development.
2. La Porte County hereby commits the requisite local funds in the amount of two hundred and fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) in the form of the general fund that is one hundred percent reimbursable by the State of Indiana Office of Community and Rural Affairs.




