**RESOLUTION TO OPT BACK IN TO OPIOIDS SETTLEMENT  
PURSUANT TO INDIANA CODE 4-6-15-2**

**WHEREAS**, LaPorte County has been actively engaged in pursuing damages caused by the manufacture, sale, and distribution of opioids through outside counsel in multidistrict litigation; and

**WHEREAS**, recent legislation amending Indiana Code 4-6-15 has been adopted by the Indiana legislature and signed into law by the Governor; and


**WHEREAS**, LaPorte County, Indiana, after due consideration of said legislation, has determined that it is in the best interest of its citizens to opt back in to the opioids' settlements under Indiana Code 4-6-15-2.




