In these exhilarating times for the construction and building industries in Northwest Indiana, "work practices are becoming increasingly more technical and specialized. Environmentally sensitive green construction methods and renewable energy technologies also are driving demand for a more highly skilled workforce. There is an increased need for skilled workers in these industries."
- We Build Northwest Indiana is a resource for people interested in a construction and maintenance related career. While some opportunities require a college degree, most require a comprehensive training and education program known as an apprenticeship. We Build Northwest Indiana welcomes you to explore the various career opportunities available in the Northwest Indiana construction industry. - The United States Department of Labor Office of Apprenticeship defines apprenticeships as a "unique, flexible training system which combines job related technical instruction with structured on-the-job training experience." Trades such as ironworker, operating engineer, sheet metal worker, carpenter, electrician, construction laborer, roofer, millwright, boilermaker, plumber, painter, glazier, cement finisher, HVAC tech, and bricklayer are examples of the building trades careers that provide good living wages for families across La Porte County and Northwest Indiana.

- According to John Carr, Senior Representative for the IN/KY/OH Regional Council of Carpenters, "Apprenticeships in the trades are a great opportunity for people who want on-the-job training and a valuable education in order to increase their access to quality jobs. Other benefits to this pathway include career advancement, credentials, technical skills, good benefits and wages, and job security. Also, our apprentices do not have any debt at the end of their training. This is an 'earn while you learn' program that is funded by the union and our signatory contractors." Thanks to this program, by the time an apprentice finishes their education, they are debt-free and already have the experience to thrive in the workforce.
- Most apprentices begin employment day one, with incremental wage increases as they advance and become more proficient on the job. For example, construction apprenticeship programs last from 3 to 5 years in length. Once the apprenticeship period is completed and the student passes all of the required-coursework, he or she will have the technical skills necessary to be recognized as a master craft professional.
- Apprenticeship programs can be challenging, but they are the pathway to a full and
 rewarding career pathway. Individuals who demonstrate the special blend of academic,
 mechanical aptitude, and physical requirements will qualify. Qualities of successful
 applicants include strong work ethic, positive attitude, and dependability. General,
 minimum qualifications include being at least 18 Years Old, in good physical shape, and
 drug-free and having a valid driver's license, reliable transportation, and a high school
 diploma (or equivalent.)
- According to the Bureau of Labor Statics, employment in construction and extraction occupations are projected to grow 4% from 2019 to 2029. A skilled tradesperson working in the building trades can expect to earn anywhere from \$70,000 to \$90,000 depending on the trade and hours worked. In addition, people employed in the building trades receive health and welfare benefits as part of their benefit package. Most plans provide some form of medical, prescription, dental, vision, weekly accident and sickness, death and or dismemberment benefits. Most building trade employees also receive defined benefit pension plans depending on the trade.²
