COUNTY COUNCIL OF LAPORTE COUNTY, INDIANA RESOLUTION NO. 2024- 8

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PER DIEM PAYMENT TO ASSESSOR AND DEPUTY ASSESSOR FOR CONTINUOUS REASSESSMENT ACTIVITIES

WHEREAS the Council is the fiscal body of LaPorte County;

WHEREAS prior to 2014, the County used an outside vendor Tyler Technologies to perform property reassessment in the County. The cost for such services was over one million dollars;

WHEREAS Indiana Code Section 36-2-7-13 grants the fiscal body the authority to pay the County Assessor a per diem rate for each day the Assessor provides reassessment activities. This compensation is in addition to the Assessor's compensation fixed under Indiana Code Section 36-2-5;

WHEREAS the County Assessor and Deputy Assessor perform reassessment activities every day, as LaPorte County is on a four-year rolling schedule where one quarter of the County's properties are assessed every year;

WHEREAS the LaPorte County Council, prior to 2014 approved payment of a per diem rate in accordance with IC-36-2-7-13;

WHEREAS the per diem rate for the years 2023 and 2024 is \$28.60 (per day).

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LAPORTE COUNTY, INDIANA COUNCIL AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Pursuant to Indiana Code Section 36-2-7-13 the fiscal body hereby adopts a resolution authorizing the payment of a per diem rate of \$28.60 to the Assessor and Deputy Assessor.
- 2. The amount of the per diem may be adjusted by the Council at subsequent budget hearings.
- 3. The specific amount of the Assessor and Deputy Assessor's per diem pay shall be identified on the salary ordinance separate and apart from the Assessor/Deputy Assessor's base compensation.
