## COUNTY COUNCIL OF LAPORTE COUNTY, INDIANA ORDINANCE NO. 2024AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING IVY TECH INTERNSHIP FUND

WHEREAS, Ivy Tech Community College is offering internship programs to students who are completing a course of study in the technology field.

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioner has approved the internship program for the LaPorte County IT Department.

WHEREAS, LaPorte County has been approved to host/employ student interns for a four-week period, up to 20 hours per week.

WHEREAS, Ivy Tech will reimburse LaPorte County the rate of \$15.00 per hour plus salary FICA (7.65%) for up to 80 hours per intern.

WHEREAS this is a reimbursable grant from Ivy Tech to offset the wage of its interns, it is necessary for the County to establish a fund for the payment of the initial intern(s).

THEREFORE, the LaPorte County Council establishes the following:

- 1. A fund shall be established titled the Ivy Tech student intern fund.
- 2. The Council will appropriate <u>36,500</u> to establish the fund and pay the first intern or set of interns.
- 3. The funds in this account shall not revert to the general fund until such time as the internship program and/or reimbursement from Ivy Tech ceases. At that point in time, the funds utilized to start this fund will revert back to the fund for which the monies were appropriated.
